What does a 7 pin connector do?

For starters, the 7 pin connector uses various pin connectors to wire certain components. This means it's possible to power functions such as reverse lights, brake lights and brake controller activation without having to rewire your vehicle or trailer separately. One of the pins is specific to providing constant 12V power to your battery.

Can You charge a trailer battery while driving?

More on this is below. Charging your trailer or travel trailer battery while driving is best if you use your 7 pin to charge. As you drive, your alternator (on your tow vehicle) provides constant power, usually around 14.5V. With a 12V system, you can safely operate from 12V to just over 14.5V.
