What are arizer Solo II batteries & chargers?

Arizer Solo II Batteries and Chargers are manufactured to strict quality standards, specifically for use with the Solo II. Only use official Solo II Batteries & Chargers. Do not use any third-party, counterfeit, or unknown brand batteries or chargers.

Can I tamper with the arizer Solo II battery?

Do not tamper with or misuse the Arizer Solo II Battery, and do not use damaged/defective batteries or Solo II devices. Arizer Solo II should be stored in a safe, temperature controlled, cool, dry place. Do not store in extreme temperature environments. Extreme heat or cold can damage the device and/or battery.

What battery does arizer solo vaporizer use?

Arizer Solo Vaporizer is powered by a 2S 7.4V Lithium Ion battery pack. The original capacity is 2200 mAh. In this tutorial, I'm using my favorite Panasonic NCR18650B 3400 mAh cells to upgrade the pack with some extra boost. 22AWG or 20AWG stranded wire, red, black and white (or any other color to separate from red or black)

What's new in arizer solo 2?

The much anticipated Solo 2 is Arizer's predecessor of the very popular Solo. The new design is much slimmer, sturdier build, has a digital display and some awesome vapor production. So let's tear it apart :-D The only visible screws are on the base plate so let's start there. This requires a T5 Torx screwdriver.

How long do arizer batteries last?

Arizer Batteries meet rigorous quality standards. With normal use they will last for hundreds of charge cycles before losing any capacity. Dropping the battery or the unit can result in battery damage that may limit/reduce the battery capacity quickly, so it is important to handle your unit carefully.

What should I know about arizer solo vaporizer?

You should be proficient in soldering and have basic understanding of electricity and electronics. I take no responsibility for any damage that you may cause to your unit. Arizer Solo Vaporizer is powered by a 2S 7.4V Lithium Ion battery pack. The original capacity is 2200 mAh.

Using a small flat tip screwdriver, carefully pry open the battery compartment cover tabs on both sides of the unit (4 total), while pushing the cover away from the unit.

Remove the depleted battery and replace it with a fully charged battery, making sure the "+" (positive) end

goes in first and the "-" end is at the bottom cover position. Replace the battery ...
