



Battery tender should be solid green

What does a green light mean on a battery tender?

Also, if the green light keeps flashing while the red light stays on, it indicates that the battery is more than 80% charged and is ready to use. You can also wait a few more minutes for the battery to be fully charged, as indicated by the green light turning solid green. How Long Does It Take for the Battery Tender to Turn Green?

What does a battery tender light mean?

Solid red light: Your Battery Tender is not charging. Flashing green light: Your Battery Tender is charging your battery. Solid green light: Your Battery Tender has finished charging your battery and is now maintaining it. Can you leave a Battery Tender on all the time? Yes, you can leave a Battery Tender on all the time.

What does a green light on a tender mean?

Think of yellow as a pit stop for fine tuning and inspection before the battery gets the green flag! While a solid green light means good to go, when the red and green lights alternate it means trouble. This flashing combo indicates the tender's safety timer has expired or the battery itself is defective.

Why does my battery tender turn green?

If the connection is secure, but the battery tender continues flashing green and never turns solid green, it may be time to replace the battery charger. If the battery tender green light stays on, it indicates that the battery is fully charged, and you can unplug the charger. However, you can also leave the battery connected to the tender.

How many volts does a battery read before attaching a tender?

The battery reads 12.7 volts before attaching the tender. I have a battery on the tender right now. The red light is lit solid. It's been on there several hours. I'm not very electrically inclined, but I would think that 12.7 volts is more than 80% charged and the red light should at least be flashing, if not solid green.

How do I know if my Battery Tender is fully charged?

You will see an amber light on your Battery Tender when the device is powered on and plugged in. The Battery Tender will have to be plugged into a wall outlet that is delivering AC power to the device. A green light will start to flash when your battery is almost fully charged - with most Battery Tenders this is at 80%.
