What is HECO's program called?

HECO's program is called Battery Bonus Program. It is designed to address an emergency energy reliability shortfall caused by the retirement of the AES coal plant. HECO is providing an upfront compensation payment to pre-schedule a battery system to perform a specific task in exchange for that payment.

Does Heco net energy metering offer a battery bonus?

If you are an existing HECO Net Energy Metering (NEM) customer, enrolling in the Battery Bonus program allows you to add additional solar capacity to your roof. In Hawaii, this can reduce the overall payback period of the system by offsetting more of your electricity costs with solar, resulting in even more savings sooner.

Can I add more solar power to my Heco net energy metering account?

Existing HECO Net Energy Metering (NEM) customers that enroll one or more batteries in the Battery Bonus program can also install additional solar capacity and retain their NEM interconnection, as long as the additional PV capacity is not more than double the battery kW rating.

What is Heco's new solar program?

HECO's new program, Smart Renewable Energy (or Smart DER), was approved by the Public Utilities Commission. According to a news release, it replaces all previous rooftop solar programs, with the exception of Net Energy Metering.

Are Heco's new programs disincentive sharing solar energy with the grid?

Energy experts have criticized HECO's new programs, saying they disincentive sharing solar energy with the grid, according to reporting from Grist. The BYOD program provides households with incentives to deliver power to the grid during peak demand, but the compensation is not as much as the Battery Bonus program.

What is HECO's pre-schedule program for batteries?
